

Admissions/Registrar

Recognizing that children are a precious gift from God and seeing our mission as being a helping partner to Christian families in the nurturing and training of their children, we prayerfully present the following admissions standards and registration standards for Veritas Christian Academy.

- Veritas Christian Academy is a discipleship model school. Believing that God has given parents the primary responsibility to instruct their children in love and fear of the Lord, we perceive our mission to be one of reinforcing and supplementing the religious training given in the home. Therefore, it is required that at least one parent (or guardian) be a professed Christian. Our Christian parents should be affiliated and in good standing with a local Christian congregation. We maintain that church attendance is essential in the spiritual training of students at Veritas Christian Academy. Parents (Guardians) should also be actively participating in the ongoing religious training of their children at home. We do require a Pastoral Reference during the initial admissions process.
- Veritas Christian Academy maintains the expectation that families understand, support, and align with the school's Statement of Faith and the mission and values that guide our community.
- Believing that God has given to the parents the responsibility of child discipline, we do not see as our purpose the task of bringing under control children who are in rebellion against parental authority.
- Veritas Christian Academy does not discriminate on the basis of race, gender, or national origin in the administration of its admissions policies.
- While recognizing the value, worth, and God-given potential of every child, Veritas Christian Academy seeks to serve students within the scope of the resources and professional training available to our faculty and staff. In some cases, we may be unable to offer admission to students whose medical or educational needs require specialized services beyond what we are equipped to provide.
- In accordance with state health regulations, the school requires written verification each year of every student's immunization status. Documentation must be provided whether immunizations are complete, partial, or an approved exemption is on file.
- To ensure proper procedures are followed, the Admissions Office must first receive approval from the Business Office before releasing any report cards, student records, or additional documents. If a report card is being held for a particular quarter or term, please contact the Business Office for further assistance.
- Families currently enrolled at Veritas Christian Academy receive priority consideration during the enrollment period for the upcoming academic year. Our school operates under a **continuous enrollment policy**, meaning students are automatically enrolled for the next school year unless a **Notification of Withdrawal Form** is submitted.

Student Records Release

Veritas Christian Academy will release official student records to another school upon the request of the parent or guardian or student who reaches the age of majority. Parents may obtain unofficial copies of student records while the student is enrolled, even if the student is 18 years of age or older. After graduation, records may be requested only by the student. Written notification for official or unofficial copies should be sent at least one week prior to when the records are needed to allow appropriate time to comply with the request. Records will not be released until all financial obligations have been met. Due to confidentiality issues, Veritas Christian Academy does not fax student records.
