

## Scholé Studio Program Overview

The Scholé Studio exists to support students with identified learning needs through the integration of Classical Christian education and specialized academic support. The program provides a peaceful, appropriately paced learning environment where students are guided with excellence, patience, and care. Scholé seeks to meet students where they are while steadily equipping them to grow in skill, confidence, and independence.

## Admission and Eligibility

Enrollment in the Scholé Studio is determined by the Scholé Director in collaboration with parents and faculty. Placement is based on documented learning needs and the school's ability to provide appropriate support.

For students in third grade and above, families are required to provide either a formal medical diagnosis or a full psychoeducational evaluation within one year of enrollment in order for the student to continue participating in Scholé.

## Scholé Contract and Continuation

Each Scholé student is supported through an **annual Scholé Contract**, also referred to as a Student Success Plan (SSP), which outlines accommodations, goals, and responsibilities.

Unless otherwise discussed, **the Scholé Contract automatically carries over from one school year to the next** to ensure continuity of support.

Progress is reviewed regularly, and adjustments are made as needed through collaboration between parents, classroom teachers, and Scholé staff.

### Roles and Responsibilities

- **Parents** are expected to partner actively with the school, attend meetings, provide required documentation, and support learning strategies at home.
- **Students** are expected to participate fully, engage respectfully, and work toward increasing independence as developmentally appropriate.
- **Scholé Staff** provide targeted support, monitor progress, collaborate with teachers, and guide instructional decisions.

## Scope of Services

Schol  provides academic support and accommodations designed to help students access the curriculum. The program does not replace classroom instruction nor guarantee specific academic outcomes. Services are limited by staffing, scheduling, and the school's capacity to meet individual needs.

## Program Review and Exit

The decision regarding when a student has graduated from the Schol  Studio rests solely at the discretion of the Schol  Studio team, based on demonstrated readiness and sustained independence. Continued placement in Schol  also requires consistent partnership and engagement from both parents and students. When this partnership is not present, the school reserves the right to reevaluate a student's participation in the program.
