

Job Description: Art Teacher (Logic & Rhetoric School) – Part-Time

We are seeking a creative, dependable, and enthusiastic Art Teacher to join our school community. This part-time position offers the opportunity to inspire students through engaging visual arts instruction in a supportive educational environment. The primary responsibility of any employee at Veritas Christian Academy is to profess and model faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord, to evidence through word and deed a commitment to Truth as it is expressed in the Bible, and to be ready and able to clearly and authentically share the gospel of Jesus Christ with students.

Position Overview

The Art Teacher will plan and lead age-appropriate art lessons, encourage creativity and artistic skill development, and foster an appreciation for the visual arts. The ideal candidate enjoys working with students, communicates effectively, and creates a positive, organized classroom environment. As part of Veritas Christian Academy's classical Christian educational model, the Art Teacher will help students recognize and appreciate truth, goodness, and beauty through the visual arts while developing both artistic skill and thoughtful observation.

Logic School (8th Grade Art)

- Teach 8th Grade Art classes.
- Schedule: Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday, 2:35–3:25 p.m.
- Assignment covers two trimesters.
- The 8th Grade Logic Art course introduces students to the foundational principles and elements of art through the lens of a classical Christian education. Students will develop technical skills while learning to think carefully about artistic choices, craftsmanship, and the historical traditions of visual art.

Third Trimester Opportunity

Depending on the candidate's experience and interests, there may be an opportunity to continue teaching during the third trimester by:

- Teaching a visual arts elective based on the candidate's area of expertise, such as ceramics, printmaking, fiber arts, drawing, painting, or another studio art discipline (ceramics experience is preferred if a ceramics course is offered), or
- Leading a Grammar School Art Club, meeting approximately Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday from 2:45–4:00 p.m. (schedule may be flexible).

Rhetoric School Art

We are also seeking availability to teach Rhetoric School Art.

Preferred schedule:

- Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday
- 1:40–2:30 p.m.

If a four-day schedule is not possible, we will also consider candidates who are available on either:

- Monday & Thursday, or
- Tuesday & Friday.

Responsibilities

- Plan and deliver engaging art lessons appropriate for the assigned grade levels.
- Prepare classroom materials and maintain an organized art space.
- Encourage creativity, artistic exploration, and skill development.
- Integrate instruction with the school's classical Christian educational philosophy by helping students connect artistic skills and assignments to the pursuit of truth, goodness, and beauty.
- Foster a respectful, positive classroom environment.
- Communicate professionally with school staff and families as needed.
- Support the school's mission and community through excellent instruction and student engagement.

Qualifications

- Experience teaching art or working with children or adolescents is preferred.
- A mature Christian who demonstrates biblical character and servant leadership.
- Background in visual arts, art education, or a related field is desirable.
- Experience with or understanding of classical Christian education is preferred. Candidates without prior classical education experience should demonstrate a willingness to learn and teach within the school's classical philosophy.
- Experience in ceramics is a plus for candidates interested in teaching a ceramics elective, though expertise in other studio art disciplines is also welcomed.
- Strong classroom management, communication, and organizational skills.
- A passion for encouraging creativity and helping students grow in confidence and artistic expression.

Schedule and assignments are subject to change based on school needs and can be discussed further during the interview.
